Dear Parent/Carer

I hope that you and your families are safe and well.

As a school it is important we have high expectations of all of our students and we have held assemblies across all year groups recently to remind students of this. As always we work closely with parents/carers and would welcome your support with the following;

Uniform

- Students must be in full uniform, including, trousers/skirt, shirt, tie, blazer and black shoes. Trainers are not permitted.
- Students may wear a dark coat but should not be wearing hoodies or sports tops, these will be confiscated if worn.
- Lanyards and badges should be worn as part of the uniform and students must request a new one from their tutor asap.
- Full PE kit should be worn which should have the school logo on. Branded sportswear should not be worn.
- If you need help/support with the purchase of the correct uniform, please let your tutor or head of year know so we can support you.

Mobile Phones

- Mobile phones should not be out in school, they should be switched off and kept in a bag or blazer. If a phone is seen then it will be confiscated until the end of the day. If your child repeatedly has their phone confiscated you may be asked to collect it.

Standards

- Students should follow the school behavior policy and should ensure they act respectfully around the school, to each other, staff and the school building.
- Courtesy towards staff should be shown at all times.
- Students should move around the site in a safe manner and ensure they are particularly careful when moving in the corridors.
- If students do not follow the rules of the school then your child may be sanctioned as per the school behavior policy.
- Students need to be on time to school as gates close on time, particularly at the back of school on Marshall Street, where if they are late they are then even later as they then are having to walk round to the front gate. This gate closes at 8.45am.

COVID Safe

- Students must come to school and leave through the correct entrance.
- Students will need to continue to wear face coverings whilst government guidelines recommend this I am pleased with the seriousness most students show regarding face coverings. Your child may need to bring spares if they tend to break them, please also check in the morning they have one with them.
- Students need to remain in the year zone for the day.
