Ensure your contact details are correct when completing on-line applications. Institutions will contact you as soon as they can. They may ring you to carry out an interview or offer you a place subject to the information you have provided on your application</p>	<p>Continue to search for vacancies. Use www.apprenticeships.gov.uk and contact training providers who have links with employers offering apprenticeships. Speak to Sally and Maxine for further information on providers.</p> <p>Draft a CV - it's a good idea to have one ready just in case you need to send it to employers.</p> <p>Make sure you have applied for a full-time college course as your back up plan.</p> <p>If you are considering study programmes offered at training providers (e.g. Nacro, Juniper, Nova, Skills Training) speak to your Connexions Advisers for information and we can help you to sort out a place.</p>	<p>Speak to your Connexions Advisers Ravi and Kukki who will help you look at your options.</p> <p>Keep your options open! You could research the types of apprenticeships available as well as college and training courses.</p> <p>You can still visit college websites to find out about courses – consider applying just in case you later decide this is what you want to do.</p>
